Teacher Mini Grant Guidelines

What is the purpose of the mini-grants?

The grants are intended to assist teachers by providing funding for special projects and educational tools.

Who is eligible to apply for the mini-grants?

Pre-K through 12th grade teachers at schools in the Zachary community, including special education, music, band, etc. are eligible. Multiple teachers may submit a joint application.

What are the criteria for choosing recipients?

The primary selection criteria are:

- student participation*
- creativity*
- number of students involved*
- clarity of plans, objectives and expenditures*

What is the maximum dollar amount awarded?

\$100 - \$1,000

When are the applications due?

Applications are due by Friday, January 13. They should be emailed to zacharycharityleague@gmail.com. Applications received after the deadline WILL NOT be considered.

When will the recipients be notified?

Recipients will be notified by Monday, January 30.

Is anything required of the recipients?

A follow-up report may be sent to teachers near the end of the school year. This report must be completed by May 31, 2023, if the recipient would like to be eligible for the next calendar year Mini Grant Program.
